Miss the last Board meeting?

- Financials were reviewed and disussed
 - As of 01/31/24: Operating Account balance was \$241,955.37 and Reserve Account balance was \$199,043.34.
 - As of 01/31/24, current balance of outstanding assessments was \$37,407.32 which is 42 homeowners delinquent on HOA dues.
- Carrollton Council Member Christopher Axberg was a guest speaker at the meeting.
 - Provided update on Sky/Stallion issues from the city's perspective
 - Requested that homeowners contact Code Enforcement regarding the lack of upkeep at the Remarkable nursing facility
- Maintenance, Repairs and Upkeep
 - Bids are being obtained to address the issues with sidewalks in the Amenities Center parking lot
 - Seeking to obtain bids to replace existing lighting at the Corral pond with LED lights
- New Business
 - Discussed approaching business owners within the neighborhood to potentially consider sponsorship of amenities (benches, playground equipment, etc.)
 - Discussed charging a security deposit for Amenities Center reservations to offset the cost of it not being cleaned up after events.





Stallion/Sky Construction Update

Construction on the retaining wall has been completed and they are backfilling all of the soil that has been lost. Crews are now working removing the concrete from the existing sidewalk and road and are installing concrete storm drains to divert water to the creek by the railroad tracks. Once completed they will be replacing the irrigation system.

Update on Stallion Sky Lawsuit

- 1. We have received an opinion letter from the Attorney General related to our open records request. Because the City has been threatened with suit pertaining to our claims (by JGBL), the City is exempt from producing records to us;
- 2. A new trial date has been tentatively agreed upon as JBGL claims it is not available now for our May setting; the new date is June 9th 2025;
- 3.We are working on getting corporate rep topics agreed upon in anticipation of depositions to (hopefully) take place in August.






Pool Remodel


We have noticed a buildup / white film on the new tile. Canyon Oak and the vendor that services the pool weekly have been contacted for their opinions on solving this issue.
